Non-Residential Burglary	BALHAM HIGH ROAD	03/03/2004	0030	03/03/2004	0050	Four suspects smashed door, causing damage, entered and stole property. 1) Female, white, 15 yrs, in pink coat with gold jewellery. 2) 17 yrs, female, white 3) male, white, 22 yrs, in denim coat, blue jumper and grey trainers 4) 22 yrs, male, white, in light baseball cap, beige lightweight coat, grey jumper and black/red trainers.
Residential Burglary	BALHAM HIGH ROAD	03/03/2004	0930	03/03/2004	1715	Burglar entered via the front door, which had been left on the latch, and stole a laptop computer.
Residential Burglary	UPPER TOOTING ROAD	04/03/2004	0330	04/03/2004	0336	By suspect entering property as a trespasser and stealing items belonging to the victim



Residential Burglary	SOUTHCROFT ROAD	03/03/2004 2100	04/03/2004 0730	Suspects broke in and stole property.
Residential Burglary	BOLINGBROKE GROVE	04/03/2004 1000	04/03/2004 1010	As female victim was opening the front door of her flat a 25 yr old black male suspect pushed through front entrance, intimidated her and stole laptop. He was wearing blue trousers and jacket and blue baseball cap.
Non-Residential Burglary	UPPER TOOTING ROAD	04/03/2004 0900	04/03/2004 1630	Suspect broke door to communal parts of flats.
Residential Burglary	BEDFORD HILL	04/03/2004 0830	04/03/2004 2330	Suspect forced entry through ground floor window and stole property.
Residential Burglary	EATONVILLE ROAD	05/03/2004 1522	05/03/2004 1530	Suspect forced entry, taking property and then attempted to make off, assaulting two police officers in the process
Non-Residential Burglary	TOOTING HIGH STREET	06/03/2004 0235		Suspect forced metal window frame, entered and forced open till.
Residential Burglary	COWICK ROAD	05/03/2004 0615	05/03/2004 0630	Suspect entered and damaged property.
Residential Burglary	UPPER TOOTING ROAD	04/03/2004 0800	04/03/2004 1700	Property stolen from bedrooms.



Residential Burglary	THRALE ROAD	06/03/2004 1030	06/03/2004	2100	Burglar, 28 yrs, white, in grey anorak, grey cap and dark trousers, entered flat and stole laptop.
Residential Burglary	UPPER TOOTING ROAD	06/03/2004 1300	06/03/2004	1500	Suspect entered through open kitchen window and stole from victim's jacket whilst he slept.
Non-Residential Burglary	BLACKSHAW ROAD	06/03/2004 1230	06/03/2004	1900	Suspect entered a room with a coded lock and took property.
Non-Residential Burglary	BALHAM HIGH ROAD	06/03/2004 1700	07/03/2004	0515	Suspect removed padlock from side gate at venue and then removed 4 bars from the window. He removed property but left it when the alarm was activated.
Residential Burglary	GASSIOT ROAD	07/03/2004 0200	07/03/2004	0500	Suspect entered premises and removed property while owners were asleep upstairs.
Residential Burglary	GILBEY ROAD	07/03/2004 0900	07/03/2004	1200	Suspect smashed front door gaining access to communal area and then attempted to break into other flats.
Residential Burglary	MITCHAM ROAD	07/03/2004 1730	07/03/2004	1738	Suspect smashed the front communal door. He then tried to enter a locked internal door and opened victim's bedroom door, saw victim and left. Male, black, 25 yrs in dark green track suit top.
