Theft Snatch	BICKERSTETH ROAD	07/08/2005	1300	Asian male snatched victim's phone. He was wearing a red number 10 football shirt and jeans.
Street Robbery	CLAPHAM COMMON WEST SIDE	06/08/2005	1355	Four thieves intimidated victim and stole property. 1) Aged 16, white, in a red t-shirt with a dark logo, black tracksuit trousers and dark baseball cap 2) male, white, aged 16, with a cast or brace on one leg, using crutches, and with one diamond earring, wearing a white tracksuit 3) aged 8, male white, in hooded top 4) white, aged 8, in grey hooded top.

Street Robbery	KELLINO STREET	04/08/2005	2300	Two 25 year old black males, both wearing dark clothing, stole victim's mobile phone.
Street Robbery	LONGLEY ROAD	06/08/2005	2055	By two 24 year old black males. One wore a black top and red baseball cap and the other had a black top with a cream Kangol logo on front.

Residential Burglary	NIGHTINGALE LANE	07/08/2005	0345	07/08/2005	0445	Burglar entered through closed but unlocked window and stole property.
Residential Burglary	OAKMEAD ROAD	03/08/2005	2255	03/08/2005	2305	Door forced in attempt to enter.



Aggravated Burglary - Residential	RITHERDON ROAD	05/08/2005 1410	05/08/2005 1430	Three Asian males forced entry, caused damage and seriously assaulted occupier. 1) Aged 19, in blue jeans, black t-shirt and white shirt 2) & 3) aged 22.
Non-Residential Burglary	BLACKSHAW ROAD	08/08/2005 1500		Thief entered office and took computer screen, but was challenged and dropped property. He was blue jeans and a white shirt and had an identity card.
