Theft Snatch	TOOTING GROVE	06/02/2004	1830	Property snatched by two white male victims, aged about 16 yrs.
Theft Snatch	HILLBURY ROAD	08/02/2004	0940	Suspect bumped into victim and snatched bag, leaving in nearby vehicle. Male, black, 5' 6".
Theft Snatch	HEBDON ROAD	07/02/2004	1100	Suspect grabbed bag from victim's arm. 6 ft, 25 yrs, black, wearing black jumper, black jacket with fur collar, black trousers and trainers.
Street Robbery	CHILDBERT STREET	08/02/2004	2300	Suspects intimidated they had a gun and demanded mobile phones. 1) male, 13 yrs, black, in light grey hooded jacket 2) 17 yrs, black, 5' 9", also in light grey hooded jacket.
Street Robbery	BLACKSHAW ROAD	09/02/2004	1145	White female aged about 54, 5' 4", pushed victim to ground and stole phone.

Residential Burglary	WROUGHTON ROAD	10/02/2004	0655			Intruder attempted to force the communal front door by smashing the lock with a brick, but left when disturbed by occupier.
Non-Residential Burglary	BALHAM HIGH ROAD	10/02/2004	1450			Black, male, suspect, 30 yrs, 6ft, in black leather jacket and white jumper, took lap top computer from storeroom, then pushed shop assistant and left.
Non-Residential Burglary	STELLA ROAD	10/02/2004	1700	11/02/2004	0745	Intruder climbed into the back garden, entered the victims unlocked garden shed and stole property.
Burglary Artifice - Residential	MANDRAKE ROAD	30/10/2003	1230	30/10/2003	1230	Elderly woman opened door to three suspects posing as fencing workers. All were white, male aged 30- 32. 1) 5ft, wearing dark jacket and trousers; 2) 5' 8", also in dark jacket and trousers; 3) 5' 8", in black trousers, black lumber jacket and pale blue shirt.
Residential Burglary	LYFORD ROAD	13/10/2003	1200	26/10/2003	1200	Suspect stole property from house under renovation.

Residential Burglary	FONTENOY ROAD	30/10/2003	0920	30/10/2003	1915	Property stolen, apparently after entry through front door. No damage caused.
