Theft Snatch	<b>BALHAM HIGH ROAD, SW12</b>	Saturday 12th July 2003	0200	Suspects attempted to steal lap top, and then stealing handbag.

Theft Snatch	<b>ASHVALE ROAD, SW17</b>	Sunday 13th July 2003	2315	Suspect snatched a £10 note from victim, who then followed suspect. Suspect then punched victim in eye.
Theft Snatch	<b>BALHAM HIGH ROAD SW12</b>	Tuesday 15th July 2003	1300	Suspect rode past the victim on a mountain bike and snatched her mobile phone from her hand.
