Theft Snatch	TOOTING BEC ROAD SW17	Monday 16th June 2003	0045	Suspects followed victim and talked to him before stealing cash from victim's back pocket.
Theft Snatch	NR LYNWOOD ROAD SW16	Monday 16th June 2003	1435	Suspects snatched mobile phone from victim as he locked his car
Theft Snatch	BALHAM TUBE STATION SW12	Monday 16th June 2003	1550	Suspect approached the victim from the rear and snatched her phone from her hand.
Street Robbery	ROSSITER ROAD SW12	Saturday 14th June 2003	2325	Suspect grabbed victim around neck from behind, causing her to fall to her knees. Threatened to kill victim, demanded money and property and left in car.
Street Robbery	BEDFORD HILL SW12	Sunday 15th June 2003	1030	Five suspects approached victim, kicked and pushed him and stole his property.
Theft Snatch	CREDENHILL STREET SW16	Sunday 15th June 2003	2310	Suspect ran past victim and snatched property
Street Robbery	DERINTON ROAD SW17	Thursday 12th June 2003	0330	Suspects pushed victim him and stole his mobile phone.

Street Robbery	LESSINGHAM ROAD SW17	Tuesday 17th June 2003	1600	Suspects hit and kicked the victim and stole items from him.
Street Robbery	TOOTING HIGH STREET SW17	Tuesday 17th June 2003	1420	Suspect assaulted the victim and stole items from him.
Street Robbery	WOODBURY STREET SW17	Wednesday 11th June 2003	2200	Suspect engaged victim in conversation, then grabbed victims mobile from out of his hand and ran off.

Residential Burglary	MOYSER ROAD SW17	Tuesday 17th June 2003	0300	Tuesday 17th June 2003	0335	Suspect entered property through window and stole a bag from the sideboard. Disturbed by occupants.
Non-Residential Burglary	MITCHAM ROAD SW17	Wednesday 11th June 2003	2300	Thursday 12th June 2003	1000	Intruder hid at the location after closing time then caused damage to the fixtures and fittings during an untidy search of the premises
Burglary Artifice - Residential	COTEFORD STREET SW17	Wednesday 11th June 2003	1300		1325	Female suspect called stating she had broken down and asked for petrol can. Once inside stole cash from bedrooms.
Non-Residential Burglary	FISHPONDS ROAD SW17	Wednesday 11th June 2003	1700	Thursday 12th June 2003	1400	Suspect forced padlock and stole from garage
Residential Burglary	UPPER TOOTING ROAD SW17	Wednesday 11th June 2003	1830	Wednesday 11th June 2003	2230	Suspect(s) climbed scaffolding at the rear of the premises and then forced kitchen window to gain entry
