STREET CRIME

Street Robbery BALHAM HIGH ROAD	14/07/2004	1610	Suspect pushed victim and threatened violence in order to steal mobile phone. He was 23 yrs, white, wearing blue jeans, grey shirt and black bomber jacket.
Street Robbery LAMMERMOOR ROAD	18/07/2004	1220	Victim's car was forcibly taken from her by a white male, 33 yrs, in a black jacket.
Street Robbery STAPLETON ROAD	19/07/2004	1145	Two suspects stole cash after hitting victim in back. Both were male, 20 yrs, black; one wore a black top and jeans; the other had a white top and jeans.
Street Robbery BLANDFIELD ROAD	21/07/2004	0015	Victim struck on back of head and her handbag taken by a black male, 30 yrs, wearing light jeans and a black jacket.
Theft Snatch TOOTING HIGH STREET	14/07/2004	1710	Suspect snatched victim's handbag from behind.
Theft Snatch UPPER TOOTING ROAD	14/07/2004	2245	Suspect snatched cash from victim who had just used an ATM. He was wearing black tracksuit bottoms and a red hooded top.
Theft Snatch TOOTING BROADWAY	16/07/2004	2240	Black suspect, 20 yrs, asked for change and stole victim's bus pass.

Aggravated Burglary - Residential	KHAMA ROAD	15/07/2004	1240			Two suspects kicked open door, but were disturbed by resident. 1) Black male in baseball cap, blue jeans, blue jacket and trainers, 2) No description.

Residential Burglary	OLD HOSPITAL CLOSE	15/07/2004 0300		Black suspect knocked on the victim's door and, when allowed, in stole cash.
Non-Residential Burglary	BOUNDARIES ROAD	16/07/2004 1800	18/07/2004 2359	Suspect entered and stole.
Residential Burglary	CARLWELL STREET	16/07/2004 0635		As victim was asleep a black male, 25 yrs, dressed in a blue fleece, jeans and white trainers, forced the front door, entered and stole.
Burglary Artifice - Residential	FONTENOY ROAD	16/07/2004 2015		Two suspects followed victim into house after asking for glass of water and stole items. One was female, wearing a denim jacket and jeans; the other was a white male in a blue checked shirt.
Residential Burglary	LUCIEN ROAD	16/07/2004 0001		Suspect pushed his way into a flat during a party, pushed witness and stole hi-fi. He was 38 yrs, black, wearing a white t-shirt, tracksuit bottoms and trainers.
Residential Burglary	RAVENSTONE STREET	16/07/2004 0440		Suspect gained entry through a unlocked louvre window and left without any property after being disturbed by victim.
Residential Burglary	STAPLETON ROAD	16/07/2004 0900	16/07/2004 1400	Suspect slipping latch of communal front door, entered and then slipped latch on flat, and stole property.
Residential Burglary	TERRAPIN ROAD	16/07/2004 0815	17/07/2004 0200	Suspects climbed through window and took two phones and purse
Residential Burglary	TOTTERDOWN STREET	16/07/2004 0150	16/07/2004 0155	Suspect climbed in through ground floor front bedroom window, disturbing the victim, who screamed. No property taken.



Residential Burglary	BEDFORD HILL	17/07/20040300	17/07/20040600	Two suspects climbed exterior wall to hostel, breaking drainpipe, then smashed side window, entered, and caused damage. 1) Female, white, 25 yrs 2) Male, black, 25 yrs, wearing a white shirt.
Residential Burglary	CAVENDISH ROAD	17/07/20042300	18/07/20041600	Suspect entered and stole.
Residential Burglary	ROWFANT ROAD	17/07/20042359	18/07/20040800	Suspects entered and removed the safe and contents.
Residential Burglary	ALDERBROOK ROAD	18/07/20041545	18/07/20041555	Suspect broke window and gained entry to communal hallway and then attempted to force the flat doors. He was a black male, wearing jeans and no top.
Residential Burglary	CATHLES ROAD	18/07/20042145	18/07/20042215	Suspects entered by forcing patio door open. He stole property, but left when disturbed by occupier. He was black, wearing a white t-shirt, dark blue denim jacket, and jeans.
Residential Burglary	FONTENOY ROAD	18/07/20040630	18/07/20040730	Thief entered through bathroom window and stole property.
Residential Burglary	SHIPKA ROAD	18/07/20042121		16 year old black youth forced bedroom window open then climbed through. When disturbed he ran off. He wore a white top and black jeans.
Residential Burglary	BALHAM GROVE	19/07/20040945	19/07/20041350	Suspect slipped latch on front door, entered and stole property. He was aged about 23, black, of scruffy appearance.
Residential Burglary	BICKLEY STREET	19/07/20042359	20/07/20040700	Suspect entered and took property from living room
Non-Residential Burglary	MITCHAM LANE	19/07/20041715	19/07/20041730	Suspects broke lock on garage door, entered premises and stole items.



Non-Residential Burglary	OLDRIDGE ROAD	19/07/2004 2000	20/07/2004 0900	Suspect forced entry to store sheds and stole.
Non-Residential Burglary	BELLEVUE ROAD	20/07/2004 2250	20/07/2004 2305	Suspect climbed a wall and then smashed a small glass window in unsuccessful attempt to enter. He was black, 38 yrs, dressed in white jogging trousers with a stripe on side and white baseball cap.
Residential Burglary	BRIGHTWELL CRESCENT	20/07/2004 0845	20/07/2004 1830	Suspect entered communal area after slipping latch then broke down door of ground floor flat, entered and stole.
Residential Burglary	CROCKERTON ROAD	20/07/2004 1450	20/07/2004 1630	Suspect attempted to force entry through lounge window, then successfully forced entry through kitchen window, entered and stole.
Residential Burglary	CROCKERTON ROAD	20/07/2004 1500	20/07/2004 1640	Suspect entered through kitchen window and stole property.
Residential Burglary	HESLOP ROAD	20/07/2004 0030	20/07/2004 0630	Suspect climbed through open window of flat and stole pedal cycle from communal area after leaving flat.
