Robbery personal property	BEDFORD HILL	17/11/2007	0900	Pizza delivery rider was threatened with a gun by two 20 year old black males, who demanded his wallet and cash. One was in black clothing with a black mask with white stripes.	BEDFORD
Robbery personal property	RYDE VALE ROAD	16/11/2007	2200	Four 18 year old males, three black and one Asian, punched victims and threatened them with a hammer, then searched them and stole property.	BEDFORD
Theft snatch	PEVENSEY ROAD	14/11/2007	2100	Victim's rucksack was taken from his back by a group of six males; four were black, aged about 17, and two were white, one 16 and the other 17.	TOOTING

They then seriously assaulted him when he tried to recover the property. One was an Asian male, aged about 60, in a white fleecy jumper and a dark hat. No description available of the second man. Alternatively, pass your information to **CRIMESTOPPERS on 0800 555 111**. You do not have to give your name or address and you may be eligible for a reward if the information given leads to the arrest and conviction of an offender.

Crimes can also be reported online, through <https://online.met.police.uk/> . This is only for non-urgent crimes, where an immediate police response is not required.

ASSISTANCE

Putney Police Sector Office, Putney High Street (next to the cinema), for crime prevention advice, property marking, etc. Open from Monday to Friday between 11am and 2pm and on Saturday from 10am to 2pm.

Age Concern Wandsworth, tel. 020 8877 8940 can offer advice and assistance to the over-50s, whether or not you have been a victim of crime. You can also report a crime and get advice at the Age Concern **Safe & Secure Advice Desk**, at 549 Old York Road, London, SW18 1TQ each Thursday from 10am to 1pm, where you can speak to a police Crime Prevention Officer, Victim Support worker or a Community Safety Officer.

Victim Support, tel. 0207 223 1234, is an independent charity that helps people cope with crime.

Trained staff and volunteers, based in local branches, contact people after a crime has been committed, to offer free, confidential support and information. The Police and other organisations refer victims of crime to Victim Support; however some people feel able to 'pop in' to one of our branches to ask for assistance.

FLaSH - Free home security and fire safety checks are available for **all** residents in the borough, including the installation of free smoke detectors and locks on doors and windows where required.
