Attached are details of the street crimes and burglaries reported to Tooting police between 16 June and 23 June, 2004

STREET CRIME

Offence Place	Date	Time	Method
Street Robbery DAGNAN ROAD	18/06/2004	0015	Three suspects followed victim then demanded his mobile phone. When he refused, he was punched in the face and his back pack was taken. They were aged 17-18, all wearing ski masks covering the lower part of their faces; one was white, with a dark hooded top.
Theft Snatch SOUTHCROFT ROAD	16/06/2004	1740	Victim was using his mobile phone when it was snatched by a 20 year old black man, dressed in a black and blue hooded top and dark tracksuit trousers.

BURGLARY

Offence	Place	Date from	Time from	Date to	Time to Method
Residential Burglary	COTEFORD STREET	15/06/2004	2300	16/06/2004	1030 Suspect forced her way into the victim's house on two occasions, demanding money and stating that she had a taxi outside. She was white, aged 18, in a bright blue sports outfit and with a gold necklace and gold earrings.



Residential Burglary	BALHAM HILL	16/06/2004 1945		Black male suspect removed window pane to gain access, searched premises and left through door.
Residential Burglary	DAFFORNE ROAD	16/06/2004 0600	16/06/2004 0630	Suspect forced latch on victim's door, then assaulted him, searched his property and stole cash. He was black, light-skinned, with a round face and pointed chin, 35 yrs, dressed in a brown waistcoat and brown trousers.
Non-Residential Burglary	CULVERDEN ROAD	16/06/2004 1930	17/06/2004 0900	Suspect climbed wall into garden, broke into shed and stole property.
Residential Burglary	NIMROD ROAD	17/06/2004 1145	17/06/2004 2345	Suspect entered and stole jewellery and cash
Residential Burglary	WOODNOOK ROAD	18/06/2004 0315	18/06/2004 0330	Suspect entered using keys and stole computer and mobile phone.
