Residential Burglary	HOLMSIDE ROAD	19/09/2003	1800	22/09/2003	0900	Suspect forced entry through boarded up window on house under renovation entered and stole from the occupied area within the house
Residential Burglary	HAZELHURST ROAD	22/09/2003	0830	22/09/2003	1630	Suspect broke window and unsuccessfully attempted to open window lock.
Residential Burglary	KYRLE ROAD,	23/09/2003	0800	23/09/2003	0830	Glass in the back door was smashed and back gate kicked in but entry not gained.
Residential Burglary	RAVENSLEA ROAD	23/09/2003	1400	23/09/2003	1429	Suspects forced entry to address locking the front door with the chain from the inside then took goods and made off through the back door
