

Furzedown Safer Neighbourhoods Team COMMUNITY BULLETIN December 2009

- **Anti Social Behaviour:** Furzedown Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) have received complaints from local residents, with regard to anti social behaviour in and around Moyser Road and Furzedown Recreation Ground. To gather further information, the team have arranged a 'Drop in Session' for Saturday 28th November from 3pm - 4.30pm, outside the Furzedown Project, Moyser Road SW16. Residents are encouraged to come along, meet the team, and discuss any concerns relating to this, or other Policing issues. We will also have crime prevention materials, and property marking pens available. The team are working closely with Wandsworth Borough Council Community Safety Unit, in order to tackle issues of anti social behaviour (ASB) and are currently working with a number of Partner Agencies, including Chelsea Football Club, in order to identify ways of diverting young people away from crime and ASB. Recently, the team have also begun working with School Council representatives at Graveney School, to set up a Youth Panel that will meet regularly with the team and look at innovative and long lasting ways of tackling issues involving young people. For those identified as habitually engaging in ASB on Furzedown ward, the team have been proactive in implementing a number of different interventions, such as the use of Anti Social Behaviour Orders, Acceptable Behaviour Contracts and issuing Penalty Notices for Disorder. If you have concerns in relation to anti social behaviour, then please contact the team or attend one of our Community 'Drop in Sessions'.
- **Ongoing Burglary Initiative:** The team continue their efforts around deterring residential burglaries, and the area has seen a marked reduction in offences. The team are keen to encourage residents to continue their efforts towards securing their properties, and remain vigilant in the run up to Christmas, when, historically, the area has seen a further increase in burglaries.
