*"We Asked, You Said, We Did"*

Your team are working on the following priorities, which are set by your ward panel:

#### Burglary.

We continue to patrol the ward and there have been a number of operations including Operation Bumblebee. Your local team have been carrying out extra patrols both in uniform and plain clothes. Response teams have been assisting with extra patrols and we remain committed to tackling this problem.

#### Anti Social behaviour by youths

We have increased high visibility patrols around the Furzedown PH and Moyser Road this includes visits to local businesses, residents and local shop keepers. We are identifying the groups involved and are working with other agencies to target these individuals.

Residents can support by remaining vigilant.

Furzedown SNT are working with the council and other agencies, the Graffiti Eardley passage has been removed along with improvements to surrounding areas.

### Crime Prevention Tips

- Lock all doors and windows when you leave home, even for a short time
- Never leave keys or valuables on view or near a door or window
- Always check the identity of visitors before admitting them to your home
- Mark your valuables - having it marked helps police recover property
- Keep garden tools and ladders securely locked away
- If you go on holiday never leave clues that you are away.
