### Locally Agreed Priorities

*"We Asked, You Said, We Did"*

Your team are working on the following priorities, which are set by your ward panel:

#### Burglary.

We are still suffering burglaries on the ward. The team are delivering crime prevention advice to all owners, landlords and tenants.

#### Anti Social behaviour by youths

The team have conducted extensive high visibility patrolling as well as plain clothes and have interacted with the youths to minimize anti-social behaviour. We have also liaised with partner agencies to come up with other alternatives on how to minimize ASB.

#### Good news

We have since stopped and removed the youths around Winters Bookmakers on Moyser Road, which has subsequently closed down. Hopefully this has ended anti-social behaviour around that area.

### Crime Prevention Advice

#### Did you know that...

Most vehicle crime is preventable. It can take as little as 10 seconds for a thief to steal something from your car. If at all possible, leave nothing on view. NEVER leave valuable items in your car, including sunglasses, the removable radio cover and your Sat Nav. Do you really need all those things you keep in the glove box? Wipe away the Sat Nav mark on your windscreen. Consider fitting anti-tamper screws to your number plate. Never leave your car keys where they can be seen from the front door.
