Furzedown SNT win national award

PC Keeley Webb represented the Furzedown Safer Neighbourhoods team who were awarded a commendation at the Association of Chief Police Officers' (ACPO) Drugs Conference in Manchester 21 November 2006. The award recognises the immediate and significant impact she has made on tackling drug problems in Furzedown.

Her close community contacts meant she was able to collate intelligence on drug dealers in Furzedown. Furzedown SNT in conjunction with Territorial Support Group and other police units seized a thousand cannabis plants, firearms, and the arrests of prominent drug dealers during two separate drugs operations.

PC Keeley Webb, said:

"The best thing about being in Safer Neighbourhoods is that you get to see a project from start to finish and tackling drugs and the antisocial problems which it brings is a priority for police in Wandsworth."

Borough Commander Joe Royle, said:

"The Furzedown team deserves this recognition for their dedication in dealing with local issues and stepping up to work with specialist squads to collate intelligence and execute search warrants on drug dealers."



Anti-Social Behaviour

Numerous complaints have been received relating to a group of youths in the Colson Way area. Residents have regularly made Police aware of behaviour, which leads them to feel intimidated and uncomfortable leaving their homes after dark. Furzedown SNT in partnership with Wandsworth Borough Council will be seeking eviction notices on any residents that can be identified as being involved. We are aware that there are a number of victims living within the area and would encourage anyone with information to contact the local SNT with a view to making a statement.

Graffiti

There has been a reported increase in graffiti incidents within The Alders off Aldington Road. Wandsworth Borough Council are currently running a borough wide campaign offering a financial reward for information leading to the prosecution of the offenders of this sort of anti social behaviour.

Working with Wandsworth Borough Council, Furzedown SNT report any graffiti seen to the council for removal, the graffiti is logged onto a data base which can be used at a later date for prosecuting the perpetrators.

We need your help to catch and prosecute the culprits of this vandalism and maintain a cleaner environment for the residents of Furzedown. If you any information or know who is responsible for graffiti in your area please get in touch with the SNT office at the contact numbers provided within this newsletter.

VEHICLE CRIME

With the assistance of Traffic Officers and an automatic number plate reader (ANPR), Furzedown SNT conducted two operations to increase the detection of illegal vehicles on public roads and interrupt the criminal network on their travels. The ANPR is able to alert Police to any vehicle with an information marker, including reported as stolen, if valid insurance and MOT is held and if the keeper is shown as disqualified. This operation resulted in 4 arrests.
