Crowborough Road - Traffic Calming

I write further to my letter dated 18th March 2003 regarding the opinion survey carried out by the neighbourhood watch into Crowborough Road residents' views on traffic calming.

An automatic traffic counter was installed in Crowborough Road near to No 53 to measure traffic volumes and speeds. Traffic volumes were low and well below the Council's criteria for consideration of traffic calming. However, the results showed that the 85th percentile traffic speeds (the speed below which 85% travel which is a recognised design criteria) were above the 30mph speed limit. I have therefore requested that the Police consider taking action to enforce the speed limit here.

Although I cannot justify measures based on my initial findings, the traffic speeds are higher than we would like on a residential side road and I have recommended that further detailed traffic investigations be carried out to encompass a wider area to determine what can be done to improve the traffic situation generally for residents. I wish to assure you that your concerns have not been discounted and further work is being done.
